"Ex-tinct"

No longer living
No longer in existence

MAMMAL

"Mam-mal"

A warm blooded animal that
suckles its young

MEGAHERBIVORE

"Me-ga - Her-bee-vore"

A large animal that feeds on
plants/vegetation

UNGULATE

"Un-gu-late"

A mammal with
hoofed feet

SOLITARY

"Sol-it-air-ee"

Lives mainly on its own
Spends a lot of time alone

PERISSODACTYLA

"Per-i-so-dac-ti-la"

An ungulate with an
odd number of toes

CRASH

"Cra-sh"

A group of rhinos
