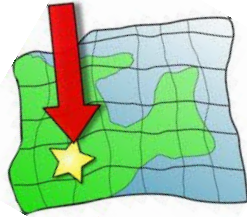


# PARACERATHERIUM

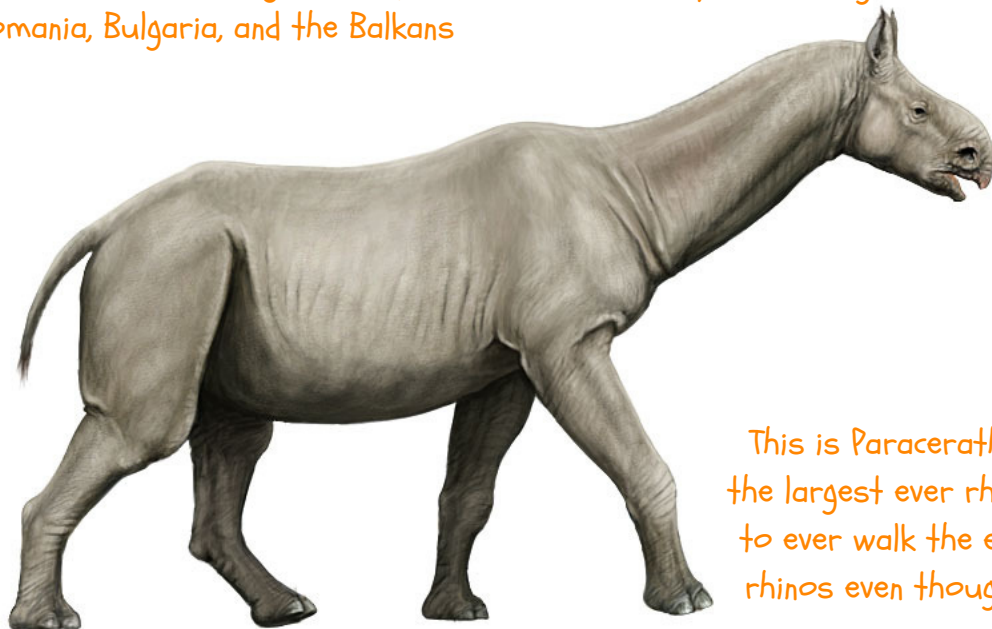
Paraceratherium bones were first discovered in 1907/08 by a geologist called Guy Ellcock Pilgrim



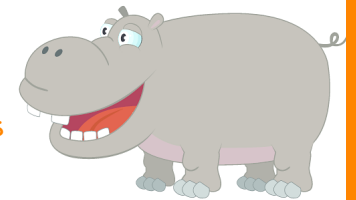
Paraceratherium's body was about 26 feet long. That's almost the same length as a London bus



Stood around 5 meters tall to the shoulder. That's about the same height as a two story building



Paraceratherium weighed around 20 tonnes. That's roughly the same weight as 4000 cats or 5 hippos!



This is Paraceratherium (pa-ra-ce-ra-there-ree-um) the largest ever rhino and the largest ever land mammal to ever walk the earth!! He is the ancestor of today's rhinos even though he doesn't look like a rhino at all.
